

# CAMPUS Asia Long-term Study Abroad Programs beginning in Spring, 2021 (Double Degree Program ONLY)

*College of Political Science and Economics, Korea University*

## 1. Program Outline

### (1) Name of the Program

#### **Double Degree Program (DDP)**

- Double Degree Programs allow students to receive degrees at both Korea University and the university they are to study in (Waseda University), if they meet certain requirements. To complete the DDP, students must have advanced skills in reading, comprehending, and interacting in foreign languages. The beginning and duration of each program varies.
- Students will be required to pay their tuition to Korea University, and will be exempted from payments to their designated university.

### (2) Offered Programs (Double Degree Program ONLY)

*\*You can apply to only ONE of these three programs.*

*\*Please note that decision on taking Campus Asia core courses won't be finalized till next year.*

*\*DDP candidates have to study back at their home university for at least 1 semester after completing their study at Waseda University in order for them to obtain a Waseda diploma.*

### (3) Eligibility for Application

1) Undergraduate students from College of Political Science and Economics  
(But they should have taken 2 semesters or more before they apply.)

2) The basic language of Campus Asia program is English. So applicants must have a high level of English proficiency equivalent to TOEFL iBT 80 or above (IELTS 6.0 or above/ TOEIC 730 or above). **Keep in mind that the final decision will be made Waseda University.**

\* Note that the TOEFL/IELTS scores are only valid for 2 years.

3) Nationality: **In principle, only Korean, Chinese (+ Taiwan, Hong Kong and Macau) students are able to apply for this program with CAMPUS Asia scholarship.**

*\* If you're not belonged to nationalities above, please discuss this issue with the staff in the college administration office before application.*

4) GPA (Should not include 'F' in your transcript)

## 2. Screening Process

The detailed information of interview will be sent ONLY TO SELECTED STUDENTS.  
You will be required to complete Waseda's application form again after you are selected after KU's interview process.

Please keep in mind that the final decision will be made by Waseda University.

## 3. Scholarship

- Waseda University

Waseda University **may (not confirmed)** provide Campus Asia scholarship to accepted students. WU may offer 80,000 yen per month for incoming students for all the programs to Waseda though there are some qualifications for that. Basically the scholarship will cover an entire duration, but may be up to 1 year at maximum according to JASSO guideline. Also, there are qualifications for that such as 1) GPA 2.3 or more / 3.0, 2) Not receiving other scholarship more than 80,000 JPY. In terms of nationality, any students except for Japanese nationality are eligible for scholarship. **Please keep in mind that the final decision will be made by Waseda University and Japanese Government.**

Also, please note that once you decided to give up/withdraw from the program (whether you are participating intensive program or double degree program), you won't receive scholarship and lose eligibility to apply for this program in the future.

You will be required to pay their tuition to Korea University, and will be exempted from payments to their designated university.

You may also be required to enroll in a separate health insurance program by Waseda University.

**\* These instructions can be changed after the detailed contents (scholarship etc.) of 2<sup>nd</sup> phrase of CAMPUS Asia Program is confirmed by both Korean and Japanese government in late 2020 or early 2021.**

## 9. Course and credit requirements to graduate

Students from Korea University pursuing a bachelor's degree at SPSE, Waseda University(DDP)

- (1) are allowed to register the unlimited number of credits per semester towards the total of 64 credits needed for a Waseda University degree.
- (2) are not required to take Japanese language courses.
- (3) are not required to enroll in seminars nor to complete a graduation thesis.
- (4) have to fulfill other credits and course requirements listed in Appendix 1.
